

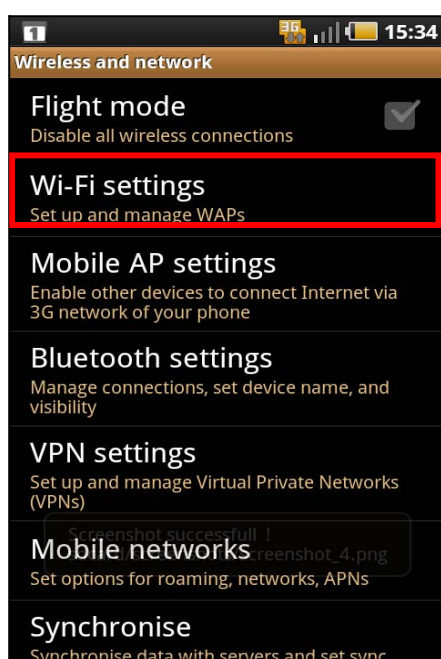
Accessing eduroam with Android phone

To configure and access the wireless eduroam network your operating system must be fully updated. And your computer must be within range of an eduroam access point.

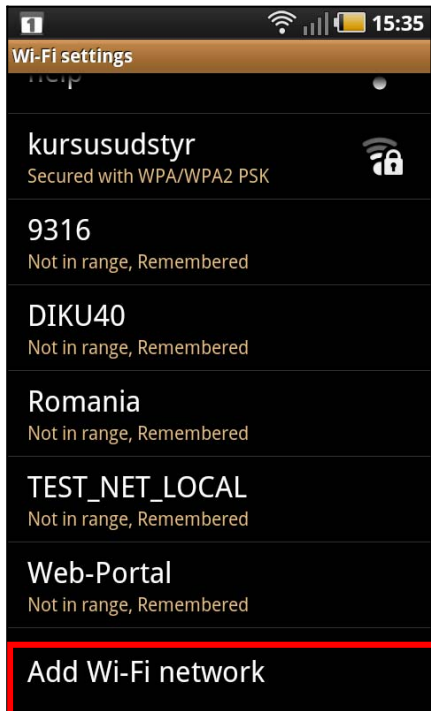


Choose **Settings**.

Open **Wireless and network**.



Choose **Wi-Fi settings**.



Open **Add Wi-Fi network**.



At **Network SSID** type **eduroam**.

At **Security** type **Enterprise (802.1x)**.

At **EAP method** choose **PEAP**.

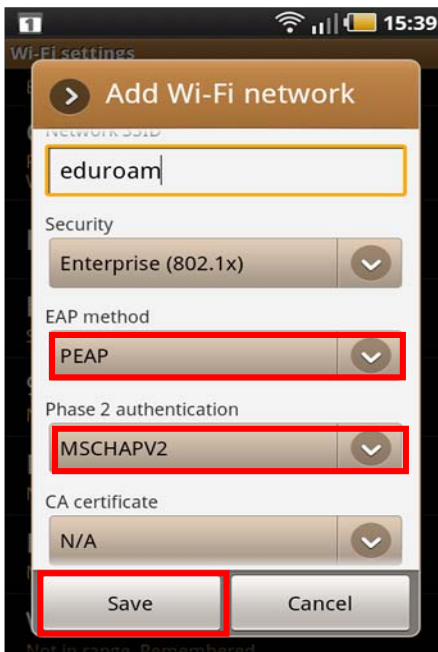
Press **Done**.



Type your password.

NB: This is **not** your KU password. It is a password for your Android phone.

Choose **Ok**.



Choose **PEAP**.

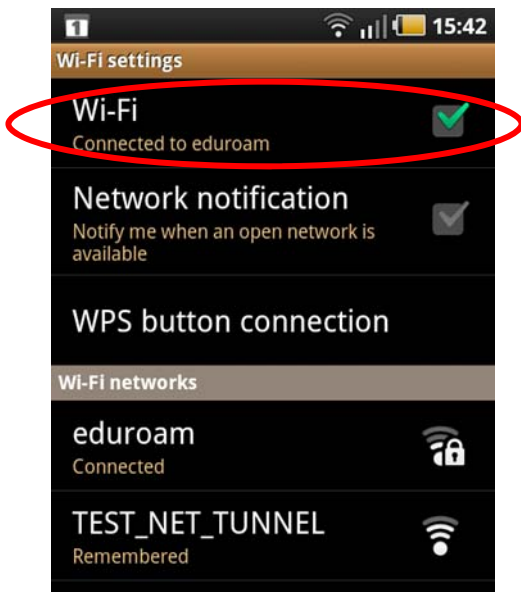
Choose **MSCHAPV2**.

Press **Save**.



Type your **KU Username** followed by **@ku.dk** and **password**.

Press **Save**.



You now have access to the wireless eduroam network. To test your connectivity go to www.ku.dk

Finally it is important to notice that your password expires every three month. When you change it you have to reconfigure the eduroam network to avoid problems.
